



- The Bloom aged care home, at 61 Laker Boulevard, Clyde North is a 3 level aged care facility
- Consisting of a basement and 2 levels above ground
- Facility designed for up to 100 residents
- Based on 'small house' model
- Town Planning allows up to 16m height in residential aged care.



- Aged care facilities are becoming large buildings, often civic in scale
- These facilities are a home, a workplace, a place where family and friends visit loved ones
- Our goal is always to deinstitutionalise these facilities and create an opportunity for the home environment, within the realms of procedure and governance required in this industry

























EXISTING DWELLING 2 STOREY RACF


